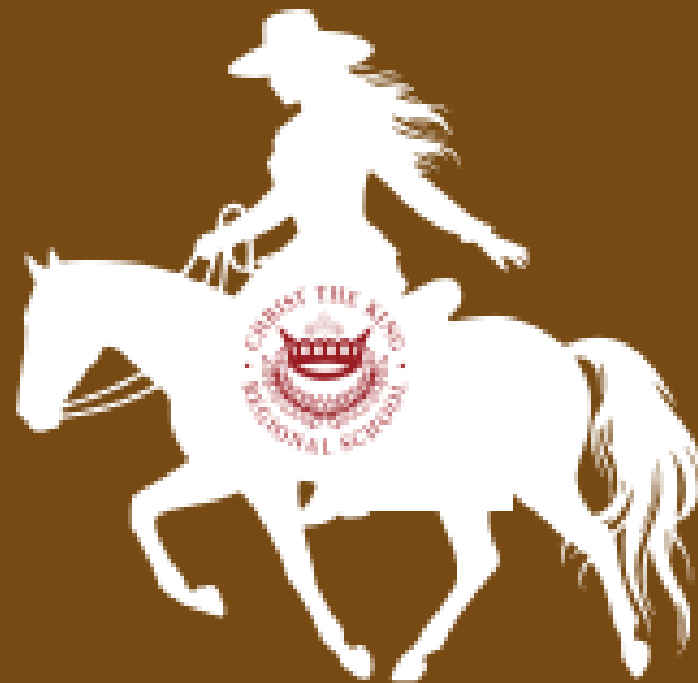

NURSE STATION

SICK PROCEDURES



Stay at home if you are feeling sick!!!

When considering sending your child back to school, please review the following:

- *Fever free (<100.4 degrees F) for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications such as acetaminophen or ibuprofen
- *Free from vomiting or diarrhea for 24 hours.
- *Rash: If the cause is unknown, please have your child evaluated by their healthcare provider.
- *Pink eye: Your child should be examined by their healthcare provider and have clearance to return to school.
- *Strep Throat: Your child should be examined by their healthcare provider and have clearance to return to school.
- *Covid/Flu like symptoms: Fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose. Take a Covid test or see your healthcare provider for a Flu test.

This is not an inclusive list, please consider if your child is healthy enough to be available to learn.

If your child has tested positive for COVID, please review the NJDOH guidelines below:

Individuals regardless of vaccination status, who test positive or individuals with COVID-19 symptoms who have not been tested and do not have an alternative diagnosis from their healthcare provider should:

- *Stay **home for at least 5 full days** after the onset of symptoms or if asymptomatic, after the positive test.
- *If they have **no symptoms or symptoms are resolving after 5 days** and are fever-free (without the use of fever-reducing medication) for 24 hours, your child can return to school.
- ***Upon return to school, your child will be required to wear a mask for 5 days** while in the school building.

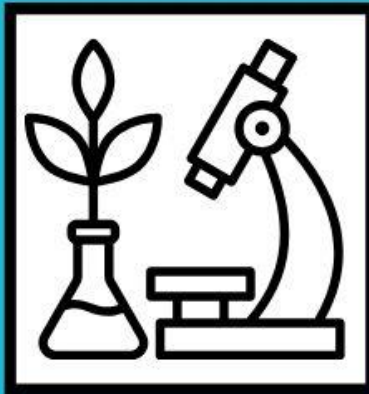

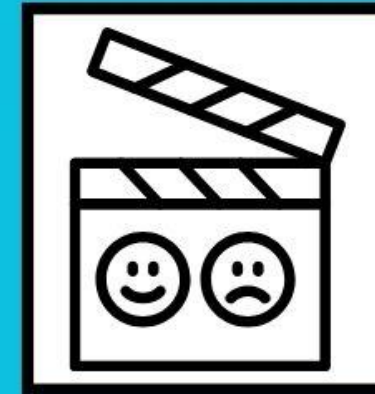
