# NURSE STATION SICK PROCEDURES



### Stay at home if you are feeling sick!!!

When considering sending your child back to school, please review the following: \*Fever free (<100.4 degrees F) for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications such as acetaminophen or ibuprofen

\*Free from vomiting or diarrhea for 24 hours.

\*Rash: If the cause is unknown, please have your child evaluated by their healthcare provider.

\*Pink eye: Your child should be examined by their healthcare provider and have clearance to return to school.

\*Strep Throat: Your child should be examined by their healthcare provider and have clearance to return to school.

\*Covid/Flu like symptoms: Fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose. Take a Covid test or see your healthcare provider for a Flu test.

This is not an inclusive list, please consider if your child is healthy enough to be available to learn.

# If your child has tested positive for COVID, please review the NJDOH guidelines below:

Individuals regardless of vaccination status, who test positive or individuals with COVID-19 symptoms who have not been tested and do not have an alternative diagnosis from their healthcare provider should:

\*Stay **home for at least 5 full days** after the onset of symptoms or if asymptomatic, after the positive test.

\*If they have **no symptoms or symptoms are resolving after 5 days** and are fever-free (without the use of fever-reducing medication) for 24 hours, your child can return to school.

\*Upon return to school, your child will be required to wear a mask for 5 days while in the school building. If you have any questions, please contact the nurse's office (856)429-2084 ext. 102 or nursesoffice@ckrs.org
